

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Boswell, Indiana, deem it necessary, in order to protect the safety, health and welfare of the residents of the Town, to declare certain conditions to constitute a public nuisance and to provide a penalty for establishing and maintaining such nuisances;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BOSWELL, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful to permit any building, structure or place to remain in such condition as to be dangerous to the public health in any way. Any such structure, building or place is hereby declared to be a nuisance.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation other than a licensed automobile, truck or farm implement dealer to keep, park, store or maintain on any public or private premises within the limits of the Town of Boswell and within public view for more than ten (10) days any dismantled, disused, inoperable, junk or abandoned automobile or motor vehicle of any description, or any junk dismantled, inoperable, abandoned or disused tractor, implement or farm tool. The maintenance of any such vehicles, implements or tools as herein described is hereby declared to be a nuisance.

SECTION 3. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to allow the accumulation of trash, junk or refuse on any property under his, her or its control. Any such accumulation of trash, junk or refuse is hereby declared to be a nuisance.

SECTION 4. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to permit or maintain the existence of any nuisance on any property under his, her or its control. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to abate any such nuisance existing in the Town whether such nuisance is specifically regulated by ordinance or not.
