

ORDINANCE 1992-1

PEDDLERS, ITINERANT MERCHANTS AND SOLICITORS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of Town of Boswell,
Benton County, Indiana:

Section 1: Any peddler, itinerant merchant or Solicitor desiring to engage in, do or transact business in the Town of Boswell, Benton County, Indiana, shall file his request for a permit for that purpose with the Clerk Treasurer, of said Town of Boswell, Indiana: this request shall state his name, the kind of business proposed to be conducted and the length of time for which he desires to do this business and he shall pay to the Clerk Treasurer, of said Town, the permit fee of \$ 10.00 per day for each and every day for which the permit is made. No permit issued shall be transferable; all permits under this ordinance shall expire 1 day after the date of issuance thereof.

Section 11: It shall be unlawful for any person, either as principal or agent to engage in the business of peddling in the Town of Boswell, Benton County, Indiana, without having first procured a permit to do so, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in the sum of not less than \$ 10.00 nor more than \$ 25.00 and each and every day of violation thereof shall be considered as a separate offense under this ordinance.

Section 111: The words " Peddler, Itinerant Merchant and Solicitor"are defined as meaning one that sells, or offers for sale manufactured goods, wares or merchandise directly to the consumer, either one or more persons going house to house for the purpose selling or delivering such goods, or the purpose of taking orders for the delivery or future delivery of such goods, or by selling and delivering such goods from a automobile, truck or vehicle on any public street or public place.

Section 1V: The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to sales made to residents retailmerchants in said Town of Boswell, Indiana, by Commercial Travelers or Selling Agents in the usual course of their business.

Section V: All permits issued by the Clerk Treasurer will show the company represented, solicitors name, address and discription and make of car or vehicle they are using.

Section VI: This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as required by law.
