

ORDINANCE NO. 1995- 2

PROHIBITION OF SLAUGHTERING, BUTCHERING AND RENDERING
WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF BOSWELL, INDIANA

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Ordinance is to prohibit the outdoor slaughtering, butchering or rendering of any animal, or animal carcass, at any site or location within the corporate limits of the Town of Boswell, Indiana, in order to protect the health and welfare of the Town's citizens and to prohibit the nuisance caused by such acts.

Section 2. Definitions. As used in this Ordinance, the following terms shall have the following meanings, unless the context clearly indicates that a different meaning is intended:

Animal: Any living creature, domestic or wild;

Outdoors: Any location which is not contained in any building or structure with four (4) walls;

Slaughter: To kill an animal for consumptive purposes, or to prepare a dead animal for consumptive purposes;

Render: To reduce a dead animal in weight or volume including the processing of dried blood and the grinding of animal bones; and

Butcher: To slaughter animals, to dress a slaughtered animal, or to divide an animal carcass.

Section 3. Penalty. Any person, firm or corporation, violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

Section 4. Conflicting Ordinances. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed.
