

dog or cat, unless the same be on a suitable leash or otherwise restrained. Violations of this subsection shall be punishable as follows:

- (a) Ten Dollars (\$10.00) on the first offense;
- (b) Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) on the second offense; and
- (c) Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) on the third offense.
- (d) After the third offense, the animal will be humanely disposed of by the Boswell Town Marshall, his or her agents, or an animal shelter or humane society.

Section 11. Revocation of Permit. The Boswell Town Council may revoke any permit if the person holding the permit refuses or fails to comply with this Ordinance, or any state or local law governing the keeping of dogs or cats. Any person whose permit is revoked shall, within ten (10) days thereafter, sell or otherwise humanely dispose of all dogs or cats owned, kept, or harbored by such person and no part of the permit fee shall be refunded. It shall be a condition of the issuance of any permit to any owner or person having custody of a dog or cat that the Boswell Town Marshall shall be permitted to inspect all dogs and cats and the premises where dogs or cats are kept at any time, and the Boswell Town Marshall shall, if permission for such inspection is refused, revoke the permit of the refusing owner.

Section 12. Rabies Inoculation Required. It shall be the duty of every owner of a dog harbored in the Town of Boswell to have such dog inoculated against rabies. The owner of such dog shall at all times keep in his possession evidence of rabies inoculation consisting of a certificate signed by the licensed veterinarian administering the vaccine. A copy of the certificate of rabies inoculation shall be presented with the application for license as required by the preceding section. No license shall be issued unless such certificate bears a date within one (1) year prior to the date of license application if a one (1) year immunization vaccine was used or within three (3) years prior to the date of license application if a three (3) year immunization vaccine was administered.

Section 13. Penalties and Enforcement. The penalty and enforcement provisions described at the end of this Ordinance shall govern all of its sections, except as provided in Section 10(2).
