

ORDINANCE NO. 2001- 3

**An Ordinance Reducing the Speed Limit on Harrold Street  
Within the Town of Boswell**

Comes now the Town Council of Boswell, Indiana, and makes the following recitals and ordains as follows:


*WHEREAS*, it has been determined, upon the basis of a traffic engineering investigation, that the speed permitted by state law on the following street or portion thereof is different than is reasonable and safe under the conditions found to exist upon such street; and


*WHEREAS*, a public park is situated along Harrold Street in the Town of Boswell, Indiana;

*NOW THEREFORE*, be it ordained by the Town Council of Boswell, Indiana, that the maximum speed limit on Harrold Street within the Town of Boswell, Indiana, shall be fifteen (15) miles per hour pursuant to Indiana Code 9-21-6-5, as that Indiana Code Section may be amended from time to time, and such speed shall be effective at all times specified when signs are erected giving notice.


