

ORDINANCE NO. 2001- 6

**ORDINANCE PROHIBITING TAMPERING WITH
THE BOSWELL WATER WORKS AND
ITS FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT**

Comes now the Town Council of Boswell, and makes the following recitals and ordains as follows:

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Boswell has invested substantial funds in the Boswell Water Works and its facilities and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Boswell seeks to control the unauthorized connection and disconnection of its Water Works facilities and equipment in order to curtail damage or unauthorized use;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Ordinances of the Town of Boswell shall be amended as follows:

1. **Tampering Prohibited.** It shall be unlawful for any plumber, pipefitter or other person or persons to attach to, detach from, or in any way tamper with any property of the Boswell Water Work whatsoever without the express permission and supervision of an employee of the Town of Boswell.
2. **Enforcement and Penalty.** The Town Marshal and all other duly authorized Law Enforcement Officers charged with enforcing the Town's Ordinances may issue an Appearance Ticket and Complaint, stating the date and time of violation, the name and address of the person violating this Ordinance, and ordering that person to appear on a certain date and time in Benton Circuit Court in Fowler, Indiana, for the purpose of a trial thereon, if contested. In the event that the person accused of violating this Ordinance wishes to admit the violation, he or she may pay such fine at the Boswell Town Hall.

There shall be the following fine for each violation of this Ordinance:

- (a) ^{Fifty} ~~Twenty~~ Dollars (\$50.00) for a first-time violation, by a member of any household or business;
- (b) One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for a second-time violation, by a member of any household or business; and
- (c) Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for the third violation, by a member of any household or business, and for any subsequent violation thereafter.
