

**ORDINANCE NO. 2003- 6**

**An Ordinance Reducing the Speed Limit on Town Streets  
Within the Town of Boswell to Twenty (20) Miles Per Hour**

*COMES NOW* the Town Council of Boswell, Indiana, and makes the following recitals and ordains as follows:

*WHEREAS*, it has been determined, after reviewing a traffic engineering investigation and considering complaints made to the Town of Boswell, that the maximum speed permitted by state law within the Town of Boswell is different than is reasonable and safe under the conditions found to exist upon such streets;

*NOW THEREFORE*, be it ordained by the Town Council of Boswell, Indiana, that the maximum speed limit on all town streets within the town limits of Boswell, Indiana, shall be twenty (20) miles per hour, except as provided below, pursuant to Indiana Code § 9-21-5-6, as that Indiana Code Section may be amended from time to time, and such speed shall be effective at all times specified when signs are erected giving notice;

*EXCEPT THAT*, this Ordinance shall not apply to the following:

1. Any public street or highway under the jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Transportation, either at time of this enactment, or that may come within such jurisdiction in the future, including U.S. Highway 41 and State Road 352;
2. This Ordinance shall not alter the Speed Limit on Old US 41, which is currently posted, and shall remain, at Thirty (30) miles per hour; and
3. This Ordinance shall not alter the Speed Limit of any street, designated by a preceding ordinance, which ordained a speed limit to less than Twenty (20) miles per hour.

*NOW THEREFORE*, any person who violates this Ordinance shall pay a fine of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$ 25 .00), in addition to any court costs set by the Benton Circuit Court.
