

E. When being approached by an emergency vehicle with its emergency lights and/or siren activated, the person shall immediately exit the travel portion of the roadway and stop, until the emergency vehicle has passed;

4. In the event of a violation, the following penalties shall apply:




A. For a first time violation, the person shall receive a written warning, and this Ordinance will be explained to them;

B. Upon a second or subsequent violation, the person's skateboard, roller blades, or similar devices shall be taken as evidence, and the Town Marshal and all other duly authorized Law Enforcement Officers charged with enforcing the Town's Ordinances shall issue an Appearance Ticket and Complaint, stating the date and time of violation, the name and address of the person violating this Ordinance, and ordering that person to appear on a certain date and time in Benton Circuit Court in Fowler, Indiana, for the purpose of a trial thereon, if contested. Each violation of this Ordinance, after the first violation described in paragraph 4(A), shall be punishable by a fine of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), in addition to court costs. In the event that the person accused of violating this Ordinance wishes to admit the violation, he or she may pay such fine and court costs at the Office of the Clerk of Benton County, Benton County Courthouse, Fowler, Indiana.

5. Each day of violation constitutes a separate and distinct violation of this Ordinance. The collection of penalties shall be conducted in any manner permitted by law. This Ordinance shall become effective after it has been published pursuant to law.
