

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF SKATEBOARDS AND ROLLER BLADES WITHIN THE TOWN OF BOSWELL**

*COMES NOW* the Town Council of Boswell, and makes the following recitals and ordains as follows:

*WHEREAS*, the Town Council of Boswell, Indiana, has received several complaints about persons using skateboards, and roller blades or similar devices, on private and public property without consent, placing wax on public walk-ways, and using said devices in a dangerous manner; and

*WHEREAS*, the Town Council of Boswell, Indiana finds that persons using skateboards, and roller blades, or similar devices, on town property interfere with the use of that property by other residents, and increase the town's liability in the event of injury or damage to property, while creating a risk to others;

*NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED* by the Town Council of Boswell, Indiana, as follows:

1. No person may use a skateboard, roller blades, or similar devices, on the private property of another within the Town of Boswell without the permission of the property owner upon whose property said persons intend to use a skateboard or roller blades.
2. No person may use a skateboard, roller blades, or similar devices, on public side walks, nor may any person place wax, or similar dangerous substances on public property.
3. Any person that uses a skateboard, roller blades, or similar devices, on public roadways, within the Town of Boswell, shall adhere to the following safety regulations:
  - A. Not use the skateboard, roller blades, or similar devices, on public roadways between sunset and sunrise;
  - B. Obey all traffic control devices, including stop signs and yield signs, and yield the right-of-way to motor vehicle traffic;
  - C. Travel in the same direction as motor vehicle traffic and as close to right side of the roadway as possible;
  - D. When one or more persons are traveling in close proximity and in the same direction, they shall travel in a single file line, so as not to obstruct motor vehicle traffic; and
