

**AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING THE STORAGE OF CERTAIN  
VEHICLES IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS  
WITHIN THE TOWN OF BOSWELL**

Comes now the Town Council of Boswell, and makes the following recitals and ordains as follows:

*WHEREAS*, the Town Council of Boswell, Indiana, has received several complaints about unplated and/or unregistered vehicles and trailers on residential lots within the Town of Boswell; and

*WHEREAS*, the Town Council of Boswell finds that unplated and/or unregistered vehicles, or trailers, situated on residential real estate decrease the value of neighboring properties, impair visibility within neighborhoods and constitute visual nuisances which need to be abated;

*NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED* by the Town Council of Boswell, Indiana, as follows:

1. No person may place an unplated or unregistered vehicle, or trailer, upon their property in a residential district, unless such vehicle or trailer is placed inside a building on such property. These restrictions shall not apply to business or commercial properties.

2. In the event of a violation, the following penalties shall apply:

A. For a first time violation, the person shall receive a written warning, and this Ordinance will be explained to them, and the person shall have twenty-four (24) hours to correct the violation;

B. For subsequent violations, in addition to assessing the costs of abating any nuisance incurred by the Town of Boswell, there shall be the following fine for each violation of any section above:

(a) Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for a second-time violation, by a property owner;

(b) One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for a third-time violation, by a property owner; and

(c) Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for the fourth violation, by a property owner, and for any subsequent violation thereafter.
