- Jim Schoen with Hoosier Associates reviewed the annual insurance needs of the town

- Resolution 2021-0914A (Cares Act Fund) Councilmen Foster approved transferring \$27,087.00 from fund to general with second by Councilmen Brody

- Drainage Board- need someone appoint to replace Mike Brody; will revisit next month after talking to prospect

Patron Comments/Concerns


- Mike Freeland inquired about the drainage hookup at 352 of why it was not completed; he will contact the state to see when they will be doing their part so the town can finish getting hooked up


