Council Member Foster Opened Meeting

- Approved Town Meeting Minutes 02.14.2023 & Special Meeting 02.28.2023, Council Member Foster motioned, Council Member Brody second

Police Department – Coltin Clark –Present

- Enforcing Speed on 352

- Ordinance Violations have been sent out, thirty day review will occur on April 15th or there after

Fire Department - Chief Kyle Brost

Water – Jim Turner - Present

- Transducer was hit by lighting again causing tower control to not work properly. Moving transducer to above ground to keep it from freezing and corroding while being easier to access
- There has been a build up on the edge of our streets, took snowplow and edged them up cleaner, will be cleaning it up
- South Smith St drainage needs some help, cleaned out the drain but Dudzik property continues to floor, suggesting to replicate the drainage we installed on Dana St

Waste Water - Travis Barrett - Present

- Attended the Alliance of Rural Water Conference
- Received the IDEM, have some minor things to spruce up

Park – Jake Martin- Present

- Installed a new toddler swing
- Will be doing park clean up before Easter Egg Hunt

New Business

- Greg Vogel-Vogel Real Estate purchased Dimmich land across from the Auxilus Company, plan on building homes or duplexes to help the community
- Electrical Work for the Community Center and Park needs updated for Christmas decorations for more outlets are needed and office needs more outlets and phone jacks to accommodate Mainstream equipment, Council suggested calling Hall Electric
- 210 N Smith, will be doing a surplus resolution and putting up for a minimum bid of \$4500. Town has Approximately \$3400 into it. Property is Build Ready with all taps present
- Basketball Court-Fencing- need a third estimate, full fencing vs Main & Adams sides, open gate vs closed gate too
- Basketball Court-Stripping Quote of \$900 was motioned to accept by President Brody and second by Foster, will be completed when weather gets warmer
- Malhaupts-Camera Quote came in to high at \$5467.43, council requested another quote
- Properties Need Cleaned up-Marshal Clark has started sending out violation notices already

Old Business


- President Brody motioned for Priority Project Resources to prepare the Comprehensive Plan was second by Councilman Foster


